SHOP MEMBERSHIP OVERVIEW & APPLICATION PROCESS

The Oregon Collision Repair Association exists to give Oregon collision repair businesses a stronger collective voice, better access to education, and a place to work together on issues affecting safe, proper, and ethical vehicle repairs.



OCRA brings shop owners and industry professionals together through education, advocacy, collaboration, legislative awareness, consumer protection efforts, and professional standards.



MEMBERSHIP BASICS

- Single-location business: \$500 annually.
- Multi-location business: \$500 annually for the primary location, plus \$300 annually for each additional location enrolled.
- Multi-location businesses may choose whether to enroll one location or multiple locations in OCRA. Membership benefits apply only to the locations that are enrolled and approved for membership.
- Applications are reviewed by the OCRA Board of Directors and review may take up to one week.
- Membership is not complete until the application is approved, required membership documents are received, and dues are paid in full.

WHY JOIN OCRA?

As a shop member, your business becomes part of an organized statewide effort to strengthen Oregon's collision repair industry.



1. STAY INFORMED

Receive updates on industry issues, legislative activity, regulatory concerns, and topics affecting collision repair businesses in Oregon.



2. BUILD INDUSTRY CONNECTIONS

Connect with other collision repair professionals who understand the daily operational, technical, and business challenges shops face.



3. SUPPORT SAFE AND PROPER REPAIRS

Participate in conversations and education focused on repair procedures, documentation, consumer awareness, and professional standards.



4. HELP STRENGTHEN THE INDUSTRY'S VOICE

Contribute to a more organized and credible industry presence when concerns need to be elevated to policymakers, regulators, insurers, vendors, or the public.



5. ACCESS MEMBER COMMUNICATIONS AND RESOURCES

Receive member updates, participate in OCRA communications, and engage with association activities as OCRA continues to grow.

HOW TO APPLY FOR SHOP MEMBERSHIP

Follow these steps to apply for OCRA shop membership.

1



ACCESS THE APPLICATION

Visit oregoncollisionrepair.org.
Go to the membership section
and open the Shop Membership Application.

The application asks for basic business information, including legal business name, address, contact information, business structure, primary representative information, and a short explanation of why your business is interested in joining OCRA.

SUBMIT THE APPLICATION & MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

Complete the online application and membership agreement. The person submitting the application should be authorized to apply on behalf of the business.

Once submitted, your application will be received for review by OCRA.

BOARD REVIEW

OCRA reviews applications before approving membership. As part of that review, OCRA may verify business information, including Secretary of State information when applicable.

- ✓ Applications may also be shared with the Board of Directors for review and comment.
- ✓ The internal review process includes up to a one-week board review/comment period before approval is recorded.
- ✓ OCRA may request additional information before making a membership decision.

APPROVAL & DUES INVOICE

If your application is approved, OCRA will create your member profile and send a dues invoice. Annual shop membership pricing is \$500 for the first location, plus \$300 for each additional location enrolled.



IMPORTANT:

Membership is not active until dues are paid in full.

NEW MEMBER ONBOARDING

After approval and payment, OCRA will begin onboarding your business as a new shop member.

- ✓ Adding your business to the member roster
- ✓ Creating a member record for association files
- ✓ Requesting your shop logo and representative headshots
- ✓ Adding representatives to member communications
- ✓ Adding representatives to the OCRA Facebook group if applicable
- ✓ Sending a welcome email
- ✓ Assigning a board member to personally welcome your business



ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP PRICING

- Single-location business: \$500 annually.
- Multi-location business: \$500 annually for the primary location, plus \$300 annually for each additional location enrolled.

Multi-location businesses may choose whether to enroll one location or multiple locations in OCRA. Membership benefits apply only to the locations that are enrolled and approved for membership.



SCRS GENERAL MEMBERSHIP INCLUDED

OCRA shop membership includes the option to enroll in a Society of Collision Repair Specialists General Membership at no additional cost.

SCRS is a national organization representing collision repair businesses and professionals across the country. General membership provides access to industry resources, advocacy, education, member-only content, Repairer Driven News, DEG estimating tips, SCRS Quick Tip videos, published research, open meeting opportunities, and preferred pricing on select tools and programs.

This benefit gives OCRA members access to both Oregon-focused industry support and a broader national network dedicated to collision repair advocacy, education, and professional standards.



SCRS requires all business locations to be enrolled in SCRS for a multi-location business to participate. If your business has multiple locations but is only enrolling one location in OCRA, you will need to opt out of the SCRS membership benefit.
